Congratulations on your new baby and welcome to the caring and supportive community of families with children who are deaf or hard of hearing. Our kids are older now, but we were once parents of babies and toddlers identified deaf or hard of hearing. We understand this can be an overwhelming and emotional time for families at first. What helped? Talking with other parents helped us feel less alone and more confident.

There are many resources, programs and services available to you. Starting out we were in a similar position to where you might be now. We learned the most helpful things to do were:

- connect with other parents
- learn from Deaf and Hard of Hearing role models
- begin early language services

What is Guide By Your Side?

- Support from parents also raising a child who is deaf/hard of hearing. Parent Guides will listen, share experiences & resources.
- Support from adults who grew up deaf and hard of hearing. Deaf/ Hard of Hearing Guides will provide perspective from their life.
- All guides are trained to support families with a variety of backgrounds and experiences.

How this Program Helps

- Many parents find it helpful to connect with others who have been through something similar.
- It helps families explore different ways to support their child's language and communication.

Who is eligible for the Guide By Your Side program?

Guide By Your Side is available to BC families whose babies or young children were identified through newborn hearing screening.
